RULES KOILAND LAKE

- A complete set of carp tackle is mandatory, minimum diameter of mainline is 0,35mm
- No side hooking baits and barbless hooks only
- Slings and cradle style unhooking mat are mandatory
- Please organize yourself in such way that the carp stays out of the water for not more than 5 minutes. Keep scales, water bucket, carpcare kit and camera at hand.
- Leadcore is allowed, braided mainlines and leaders are forbidden
- The rigs must discharge the lead in the event of breakages
- No zig rigs
- There is no baiting limit
- No particles you can use tigernuts and peanuts in pva bags
- You can use to bait up pva, spod, spomb, feeders and throwing stick
- Carp sacks are not allowed
- You can't keep fish overnight
- The cars must be parked in such manner that other cars can still pass
- On swim 4 the car can't be parked by the swim. You can drive to the peg to load and unload
- Bivvies must be green or camo or in dark colours
- If you go to the toilet you must wal or use the bike, NO CAR
- No unattended rods
- Toilets are open 24h, showers are open from 4pm till 8pm
- Dogs are welcome, the owner is responsible for his dog
- No swimming
- No liability is taken for accidents, damages or thefts that might occur at the lake.
- Arrivals are possible till 7pm
- The lake and clubhouse close at 8pm
- In the event of rule breaking, fines will be issued

Important notice: These rules are not here to limit your fishing. They are here to protect the fish and to guarantee who comes after you to enjoy his stay at the venues of Italien Carp Lakes. Our partners on site will always be friendly and try to make your stay as comfortable as possible.
